

This is the Traveler (Score Sheet) from Segment 6 of the USBC Senior Final. It is clearly indicative of what "good bridge" should be with no double digit swings... and six complete push boards in 15 hands. Solid bidding, solid play!

When two truly competent teams play one another at this level, this is what you should expect to see. Lall has a little edge going into the last half of the last day of the Final but Wolfson has the talent and the expertise to tighten things.
