Director was called at the end of the auction. EW claimed that there was a break in tempo before 6C and that was UI which suggested that S bid 7C. West thought the length of the hesitation was at least 15 seconds (said 15 seconds and that he was being "generous"). East thought length of

hesitation was closer to 25 seconds, but did not say that to the Director at the table. Both North & South thought the hesitation was about 8-10 seconds.

Director ruled that the result stands. EW appealed. The committee: Kerri Sanborn, Jeff Polisner & John Sutherlin, met by conference call.

The Director and committee noted that the USBC General Conditions of Contest state (Screen Procedures, regarding Law 16:

A bidding tray returned in 15 seconds or less normally creates the presumption that there is no Unauthorized Information (UI). A tray returned after a longer period may be considered to have made UI available if it is apparent that one side is responsible for the delay.

The committee found that the testimony regarding the length of the break in tempo was not conclusive. The committee further found that normal tempo at the five and six level, and after an unexpected response to a Keycard bid, might be expected to be slower than at other times in the auction. Therefore, the committee found that there was no UI.

The committee further found that even had there been UI, South's action was so clear that it would be allowed.

The committee therefore upheld the Director's ruling.

The committee did not assess a frivolous appeal penalty, but thought that the issue of whether such a penalty should be assessed was very close.
